Reading

Please remember to share your child's book with them at home. Amazing Autumn

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>In our phonics lessons we will continue to learn our phase 2 sounds and tricky words. We have a writing table and book corner and lots of writing opportunities in the outdoor area to encourage the children to read and write independently.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>In Literacy we will be exploring a range of texts linked to our 'Amazing Autumn' topic. We will look at the text 'Owl Babies' and some non-fiction texts when finding out about nocturnal animals. We will also write some words to describe Autumn using the sounds that we have learnt in our phonics.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In this area of learning we will be learning about numbers. We will be carefully counting objects, matching number to quantities and subitising. We will explore name and explore the properties of 2D shapes and this will be linked to our topic e.g. making rangoli patterns.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Forest School</p> 	<p>This half term we will be focusing on seasonal changes in our Forest School sessions. Eyrescroft Forest School is run completely within the school grounds; utilising the 'wooded area' to the rear of the school field. Children will have a weekly session.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>When looking at celebrations during this topic we will be finding out about different festivals and celebrations, for example Bonfire night, Diwali and Christmas.</p>
<p>EAD</p> 	<p>During the second half term, the children will have the opportunity to engage in role play, use musical instruments and explore colour. We will learn themed songs linked to our topic. We will also be learning about Van Gough's Starry Night painting when learning about light and dark.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on ball games and listening skills.</p>
