Children will need to

- Arrive at school for 7.15am
- Bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks/water bottle in a disposable carrier bag (***If your child is entitled to free school meals then school will provided one for them***)
- Bring a sun hat and suncream (***sun cream cannot be shared with other pupils***)
- Bring any medication they need for the day in a named bag and hand to the class teacher

Pocket money can be sent with your child up to a maximum of £10, it will be up to your child to look after it and will not be used to buy food and drink.

There will be no charge for the trip as it is being covered by the school.

Depending on the weather, please equip your child with suitable clothing as the whole day will be spent outside.

We will arrive back at Highlees for approximately 6.30pm.
