Reading

Your child will be given a colour banded book to read at home with an adult. When your child has read their book, the adult needs to write a comment in their reading record book. Please encourage your child to read at home every day for at least 10 minutes. Adults in school will read with your child weekly. When your child has finished reading their book more than once, it will be their responsibility to change it for a new one.

PE

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>Our key texts for this term are; The Paper Bag Princess, Tell me a Dragon and Small Knight George and the Royal Chocolate Cake. We will be using drama techniques to help the children develop their vocabulary for writing.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>We will be working on numbers within 100 and understanding their value. We will continue practising our counting forwards and backwards. As well as writing numbers as words and forming numbers correctly, we will also learn to add and subtract these numbers.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During the term we will be exploring different materials; their uses and properties. We will investigate the best material to use for specific purposes and learn to use scientific language to explain why.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will be learning about how to stay safe on the internet and we will look into the technology we have around us, for example at home, at school and further. We will also develop keyboard and mouse skills.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE, we will be looking at who a Muslim is and what they believe. This enables your child to learn in depth about a Muslim way of life and beliefs.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During our topic lessons we will be learning all about towers, tunnels and turrets We will research how and why castles have changed through the ages and look deeply into the features of castles and whether these are there to defend or to attack.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> 	<p>Your child will be learning and performing the song Hands, Feet and Heart as a class. Whilst learning the song, your child will learn different dimensions of music such as pulse, rhythm, and pitch.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>We will be creating our very own structure using our new knowledge on castles, bridges and tunnels. Throughout this, we will carefully select and use a range of materials. We will then learn to successfully evaluate our own structure.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE lessons this term will focus on team building. Children will develop key skills through a range of interactive team building tasks. Children will use a range of equipment to support them in this, both indoor and outdoor.</p>
