## CLASS NOTICES

### **Class Text**

Our class text is *Carnival of the Lost* by Kieran Larwood and *Being Me* (a collection of poems) by various authors.

### **Reading**

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home with their child. Children will bring a reading record home so they can track their reading and share this with you. We would appreciate it if you could sign this off each week and talk to your child about what they are reading. Books will be changed when children have completed an Accelerated Reading Quiz.

### **PE**

PE will take place on a **Friday**. Children can come to school in their kit on PE days. Class 6WG will be swimming in the first half of the term on a **Wednesday**. 6TM will have an additional PE lesson on Monday morning.

### **Homework**

Spellings and maths will be sent out every **Monday** and returned back into school by the **Friday**.

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on retrieval and inference skills when answering questions linked to our class text, images and extracts. Our writing will focus on writing, analysing and performing poetry; a setting description and a non-chronological report based on an inventor or The Great Exhibition.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths, we will initially focus on place value. Children will be reading, writing, representing, ordering and rounding numbers to ten million. We will also be working with negative numbers. We will then look at the four operations (addition/subtraction /multiplication and division) and focus each day on arithmetic.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>During the term, the children will be learning about electricity, understanding how to record electrical circuits using scientific symbols and conducting experiments to give the children a chance to spot patterns and carry out controlled investigations.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>We will be investigating different methods of communication and learning how search engines work. We will also continue to remind the children how to stay safe when using all types of technology.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Geography and History</b></p> 	<p>We will be studying the Victorian Era, exploring the connections between national and international history; studying the British Empire; differences between the rich and poor; significant inventions and changes in social and cultural history, particularly from a child's point of view.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>This term we will be focusing on Christianity and discussing what matters most to Christians and to Humanists?</p>
<p><b>DT/Art</b></p> 	<p>During this term term, the children will focus on printing. We will learn about the Victorian artist William Morris and use some of his work as inspiration for creating our own designs.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on a range of fitness challenges to improve the children's: speed, strength, coordination, balance and stamina. In football they will be developing the core skills and understanding the importance of respect on the playing field.</p>
