Class Text

Reading

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. Children will bring a reading record home so they can track their reading and share this with you. We would appreciate it if you could sign this off each week and talk to your child about what they are reading.

PE

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be developing our skills of scanning a text for key information in reading. In writing we will be writing a report about Boudicca and her importance in Roman Britain.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of place value in 3 and begin to look at 4 digit numbers. We will also be consolidating our understanding of addition and subtraction.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science we will be learning about how sound is made. We will learn that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear and begin to investigate patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>This half term, we will be looking at computing systems and networks. Children will be recognising the internet as a network of networks including the WWW, and why we should evaluate online content.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During this half term, in history we will be looking at the impact that the Romans had on life in Britain and the expansion of the Roman empire. In geography we will use atlases to show the expansion of the Roman empire throughout the world and Britain.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This term we will be focusing on what it means to be a Hindu in Britain. We will develop our knowledge of Hinduism.</p>
<p>Art/ D.T/ Music</p> 	<p>In Art, we will be developing our pencil sketching skills and recreating a Roman bust. In music, we will be using our voices to speak rhythmically and expressively.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on developing the fundamental skills of balancing, running, jumping, hopping and skipping. Pupils will develop their ability to change direction with balance and control.</p>
