Mobile Phones and Apple Watches

If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and walks home alone, they may bring a mobile phone to school. If a child has a mobile in school we ask that, they hand it into the office upon arrival and collect it at the end of the school day. If a child attends a sports club, they can collect their mobile phone at the end of the club from the school office. **No child must have a mobile phone on them or in their belongings throughout the school day. They must hand them in to the office.**
