## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In writing, we will be looking at adventure stories and non-chronological reports. We will be focusing on creating grammatically correct sentences, using expanded noun phrases, imperative verbs, prepositions and dialogue.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths we will continue looking at multiplication and division with particular emphasis on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and the formal written method for these. This will be followed by a unit on length and perimeter.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>There is no specific science topic this half term.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In ICT, we will be looking at sequencing sounds using 'Scratch'. As always, we will continue to work on keeping safe using technology.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>We will be learning about different religious and spiritual ways of life about prayer: This will include the practice, symbols, words and significance of prayer, as well as some key beliefs about prayer, so that pupils can develop thoughtful ideas and viewpoints of their own, about prayer.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Geography and History</b></p> 	<p>This terms project will teach children about the history of Early Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.</p>
<p><b>MUSIC</b></p> 	<p>We will be doing a Unit of Work focused around one song: Three Little Birds- a reggae song for children by Bob Marley. The children will be listening, singing and contrasting different music by various composers as well as learning musical notes.</p>
<p><b>DT/Art</b></p> 	<p>In art, the children will be focussing on the artists Heather Hansen, Laura McKendry and Edgar Degas. They will be discovering how to make drawings that capture drama using charcoal.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Year 3 will be having a Sports Coach in to teach every Thursday. They will also be choreographing ideas to develop a dance based around Alice in Wonderland.</p>
<p><b>MFL</b></p> 	<p>Year 3 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will still look at the greetings, asking people their name, the alphabet and pronouncing letter names.</p>
