ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics	In our phonics lessons we will finish phase 2 and begin to learn phase 3 sounds and tricky words. We have a writing table and book corner and lots of writing opportunities both indoors and outdoors to encourage the children to read and write independently.	
Literacy	In Literacy we will be exploring a range of texts linked to our 'Amazing Autumn' topic. We will look at the texts 'Pumpkin Soup' and 'Owl Babies.'	
	We will be creating our own Class Book about our Autumn Walk. We will also be writing some words to describe Autumn using the sounds that we have learnt in our phonics.	
Maths	In this area of learning we will be learning about numbers. We will continue to have our number of the week focusing on the composition of numbers. We will be carefully counting objects, matching number to quantities and subitising.	

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Forest School	This half term we will be focusing on seasonal changes in our Forest School sessions. Eyrescroft Forest School is run completely within the school grounds; utilising the 'wooded area' to the rear of the school field. Children will have a fortnightly session.

EAD	During this half term, children will have the opportunity to engage in role play, use musical instruments and explore colour. We will learn themed songs linked to our topic. We will be creating our own diva lamps for Diwali and we will also be learning about Van Gogh's Starry Night painting when learning about light and dark.
PF	Our PF this half term will focus on ball
