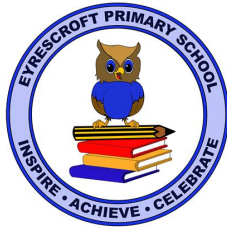

Reading

The children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. The children will have a levelled reader that will be changed on a Friday. They will also have a reading for pleasure book that they can change whenever they wish. Both can be commented on in their reading diary.

PE

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be continuing to develop skills for answering questions linked to the text we have read. In writing we will be developing sentence structure by using interesting vocabulary including adverbs (Y2) and adjectives. We will be writing more complex sentences, using 'and' (Y1) and other conjunctions (Y2) to extend our ideas.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Year 1 will be looking at fact families and how addition and subtraction facts are related, using number bonds. We will then move on to looking at numbers to 50. Year 2 will be developing our multiplication and division skills and learning to apply these skills to problem solving tasks.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this half term the children will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will investigate how plants and animals adapt to their habitats and learn about different food chains in various habitats.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>This half term the children will be learning how to create algorithms. We will develop our understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes. We will also continue learning about E-safety and how to stay safe when using technology.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>In History, we will be looking at the different types of houses that were built in the local area and we will explore changes in the local area over a period of time. In Geography, we will be learning how to read maps; and we will make maps of the local area using keys and will be noting human and physical features.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This term we will be learning about the Jewish faith. We will explore some of the objects that might be found in a Jewish home and how they link to daily life. We will also look at key celebrations such as Shabbat and Chanukkah.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>During this half term, the children will explore textiles including learning how to make a simple running stitch. They will also design and create their own building, learning to select materials and equipment suitable for the task.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE focus will be Target Games. The children will develop the skills of throwing, rolling and striking towards a target. They will learn about defending and attacking in games and the importance of following the rules of the game to keep everyone safe.</p>
