Reading

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

English

In English this term we will be focusing on inference and retrieval skills in reading. In writing, we will be focusing on poetry linking to the topic of Space, diary entries about going to the moon and balanced arguments about male and female roles in science.

Maths



In Maths, we will be learning about multiplication and division by identifying common multiples, factors and prime, square and cube numbers. We will also look at adding and subtracting fractions and converting them between improper fractions and mixed numbers.

Science



We will be learning about Space and the universe. We will carry out some investigations to help us understand the difference between day and night and sundials.

Computing



This half-term we will be video editing where we will be planning, capturing and editing video to produce a short film.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Geography
and
History

We will be using a range of ariel images of the Earth to identify geographical features. We will refer to globes and maps to make our identifications. We will also look at Sir Isaac Newton, Galileo Galilei, as well as the Space Race between the Soviet Union (USSR) and the United States (US).

This term we will be continuing to focus on the key question 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'. We will continue to look into the five pillars of Islam and describe what the Mosque is used for and why prayer matters to Muslims.
