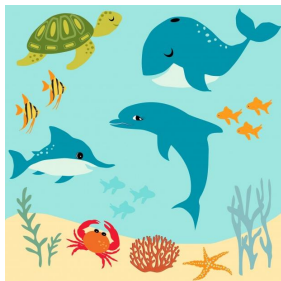

CLASS NOTICES

Reading

Children take part in daily reading sessions and activities in school. We ask that you read at home with your child everyday. Please bring your child's reading book in on a **Wednesday** so they can select a new book to take home.

Your child will be bringing home phonic decodable books which are the same as the book they are reading in school. Please help your child by reading daily with them.

PE

PE will take place on a **Tuesday**. Children can come to school in their kit on PE days. We are beginning to do PE outdoors now the weather is nice so please bear this in mind when choosing your PE kit for the day.

Please remember to look at your child's tapestry account. Each week there is information about what your child is learning in school. ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>We are continuing to use our phonetic knowledge to help us to read and write. This half term we will be focusing on using our phonics to help us to read and write sentences.</p> <p>We will continue to read and construct sentences in our weekly 'cut up sentence' challenge.</p> <p>Please ensure your child is reading their phonics book at home and returning it to school on Wednesdays.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>In literacy we will be exploring a range of texts linked to our new topic. We will explore fiction texts such as 'Billy's Bucket' and 'Sharing a shell.'</p> <p>We will be designing our own boats and then writing about how we made them and how well they float on water.</p>
	<p>In Maths this half term we will be looking at number facts to 10. We will be recalling number bonds to 5 and 10, double facts to 10. We will also explore shapes and their properties.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Forest School</p> 	<p>Children will continue to have a fortnightly 'Forest School' session.</p> <p>This half term we will focus on seasonal changes looking at changes we can see in Summer compared to other seasons.</p> <p>We will be going on a Summer scavenger hunt and making kites.</p>
<p>UTW</p> 	<p>During this topic we will be learning lots about the seaside and under the sea/ocean animals. We will look at how the seaside has changed from the past by looking at how seaside holidays have changed since Victorian times. We will also look at saving the planet by recycling and looking after our oceans.</p>
<p>EAD</p> 	<p>We have a new pirate ship role play area in the classroom. In this topic we will be making our own boats and exploring floating and sinking.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Children will develop their fundamental movement skills through the topic of 'places and spaces'. Children will develop skills of balancing, running, hopping, jumping, travelling and changing direction. Children will develop fine and gross motor skills, through handling equipment.</p>
