Reading

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In reading, we will focus on comprehension skills, answering questions linked to the text we have read. Our writing will focus on developing vocabulary and presentation. We will be writing a fact file about the life of Grace Darling using extended sentences and interesting vocabulary.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Year 1 we will be exploring numbers up to 100, including partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers. We will also learn to recognise coins and notes and learn to count coins. In Year 2 we will look at ways to present and analyse data. We will also learn how to use positional language to describe directions and movement. Both Year 1 and 2 will look at time on an analogue clock.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this half term, we will be learning about different animals including humans. We will investigate what animals need to survive and how they reproduce. We will also learn how to eat a healthy, balanced diet and discuss why exercise is important to keep our bodies healthy.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will continue learning about E-safety and how to stay safe when using all types of technology. We will learn how to design and create a simple program.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>D.T.</p> 	<p>In Design and Technology, we will be learning about mechanisms, focusing on wheels and axles. We will work in a team to design and making a Ferris wheel.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In R.E. we will continue to learn about what it means to belong and explore what it means to belong to a faith community. We will explore the ways people show they belong to each other through the marriage customs in different faiths.</p>
<p>Art and Music</p> 	<p>In Art, we will explore the work of the artist Jon Foreman and experiment with patterns by arranging and repeating colours and textures. In Music, we will investigate the importance of pitch and develop our performance skills.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE focus will be on developing our understanding of striking and fielding games. We will develop the skills of throwing, catching, tracking, retrieving and striking a ball. We will learn the rules of the games and use these to play fairly.</p>
