

End of Year Report Card

Alongside this letter you will have received your child's final report card. This gives you information regarding your child's progress, attainment and attitude. Below is a breakdown explaining what the colours mean within each section of the report card.

Attitude Grades:

General behaviour - both in class and on the playground

Green – Excellent behaviour, trustworthy, responsible

Yellow – Acceptable behaviour, some reminders of how to behave.

Red – Poor behaviour, needs frequent reminder of the expectations of behaviour within school.

Attainment Levels and Progress:

Behaviour for learning -

Green – Superb effort in all lessons. Self-motivated shows commitment to their work and wants to improve.

Yellow – Usually good effort, sometimes need reminders

Red – Rarely good effort, tasks often left incomplete
