ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>This term in phonics, we will begin to learn 4 sounds each week. Please check your child's phonic book so you know which new sound we have learnt and can practice at home. Children will access phonics in small groups with a whole class session each Friday.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>We will look at a range of key texts such as The tiger Who Came for Tea, The Little Red Hen and The Storm. Within our sessions we will look at word building and building sentences, using a capital letter and full stop.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be starting the White Rose Maths scheme; 'Just like me'. Maths will focus on numbers personal to us, around the classroom, in the home corner, finding everyday numbers and comparisons. Looking at simple patterns in numbers and comparing quantities with friends.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Forest School</p> 	<p>In Forest School we will be looking at learning the rules of the forest, how to respect our surroundings and care for living creatures. We will start making our initial observations of a specific tree area, and continue to follow its journey over the academic year.</p>
<p>Topic</p> 	<p>Within this theme we will explore the themes of ourselves; learning about similarities and differences between ourselves and others. We will talk about favourite toys, our homes and families.</p>
<p>Music & Art</p> 	<p>In Music, we will be singing lots of familiar songs and nursery rhymes, giving the children the opportunities to sing, dance, and share with us their favourite tunes. In Art, we will focus on painting self portraits, we will look at the famous painter Picasso.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE lessons will focus on music and movement. We will begin to learn how to keep ourselves healthy and look after our bodies.</p>
