

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be writing an explanation text about how the water cycle works. We will use our class text ' King of the Cloud Forest' as inspiration for a narrative piece of writing.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be looking at decimals, recapping our knowledge of bonds to 10 and 100. We will compare, order and round decimals. Then we will look at using the four operations to help with ordering and estimating money as well as finding change.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science this term, we will investigate the water cycle. We will also learn about animals that inhabit the mountains and how they adapt to the living conditions and investigate their food chains.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>This half term, we will be looking at repetition in games. We will be using a block-based programming language to explore count-controlled and infinite loops when creating a game.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>We will be learning about mountains and rivers this term, how they are formed and what different types of mountains are there. We will also locate mountains in the UK and around the world and learn about the climate in these mountainous areas.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This half term, we will continue to learn why Jesus is inspiring to some people. Then we will look at what can we learn from religions when deciding between right and wrong.</p>
<p>Art/D. T/ Music</p> 	<p>In Art this term we will be developing our skills of printing using Hokusai's 36 views of Mount Fuji as inspiration. In DT, we will evaluate existing biscuit products and make our own prototype of a biscuit.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In PE this half term, we will explore and develop our accuracy of aiming at a target. By learning how to play golf, we will use a club and develop the techniques to use over long and short distances.</p>
