Class Text

Reading

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. As a class, we discuss and read a shared text linked to our topic and check we understand the themes, characters and plot development.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on reinforcing the skills for answering questions linked to texts read. Our writing will focus on securing skills writing for a number of different audiences and purposes. Our core text is <i>Holes</i> by Louis Sachar.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be revisiting aspects of the mathematical skills learnt in Year 6. We will then use these skills in real life contexts, allowing children to see how important maths is in all aspects of life.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During the term, the children will be revising key concepts and knowledge that they have learnt through the year and building on their scientific enquiry skills.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In computing, children are revisiting their learning around e-safety and being safe online. They will consider information presented and shared, stereotyping and reporting unsuitable content or behaviour.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>We will be studying the human and physical geography of Mexico. We will look at the geographical similarities and differences between Mexico and other European countries. In history, we will study the ancient Mayan civilisation.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>In music we will be learning songs for our leavers' performance, as well as looking at a range of techniques to develop our singing and music-notation reading skills.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>During this half term, children will be developing skills in using different art styles, exploring effects with tools and creating symbolic and expressive drawings.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In PE, children will develop a skill set which is transferable to outdoor adventurous activities. This will include collaborating, problem solving, creating strategies and plans, leading and negotiating.</p>
