PE will take place on a **Monday & Thursday**

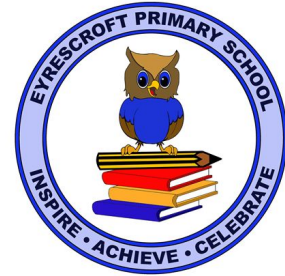

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In writing, we will develop our skills of non-fiction writing by writing a non-chronological report about the digestive system. We will also develop our performance skills by selecting a poem and performing it to our peers.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths we will begin to look at adding and subtracting fractions, as well as converting improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa. We will start to look at counting in decimals.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating, we will begin to recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear and recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>During our computing lessons we will begin to Recognise that we collect a variety of data in our day to day lives. We will collect a range of data, recording it using data loggers.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During our topic lessons we will learn about the Anglo-Saxons. We will learn about where they came from and the reasons why they came to England. We will begin to look at how the Anglo-Saxons lived and compare their lifestyle to the Romans.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE, we will continue to investigate Sikhism focussing on who were the First and Last Human Gurus, and what is the significance of the Khalsa and the Five Ks?</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>In Art, we will develop our skills of using tone and shade to create 3d pieces of work. We will focus on still life compositions considering where light sources are to create our pieces using paint,</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will continue to focus on developing our skills of movement in dance and gymnastics building on the skills that we learnt last year.</p>
