Enrichment

English 	In English this term, we will be focusing on punctuation, handwriting and sentence structure. We will use our new skills to write an advert to persuade men to join the Roman Army and send a letter to explain the arrival to England.
Maths 	In Maths, we will be focusing on place value and the meaning of digits and number. We will also be using the four operations + - x / in our 6 a day.
Science 	In Science, we will be learning about 'States of Matter'. We will compare solids, liquids and gases and explore how the particles behave.
Computing 	We will be learning about the internet. We will be looking at Online Safety and how children can stay safe online.
R.E. 	Our theme will be What kind of world did Jesus want? It explores the Christian vision for society as taught by Jesus.

Enrichment

Geography and History 	We will be learning about why the Romans invaded Britain and the impact they had and how they influence our lives today. We will focus of roads, towns and buildings. In geography we will use maps to compare Britain now and before Roman invasion.
Music 	We will dive into 1970s Electronic Dance Music! Children will play glockenspiels, improvise and compose beats. Linking to sustainability, they will sing You Can See It Through.
	In Art we will explore how pictures can tell a story and then use our drawing techniques to create a Roman visual narrative.
	This term, we will be playing the invasion game tag rugby. We will be refining our fundamental skills, learning the rules of the game and building our team work skills.
MFL 	Year 4 will be starting their MFL journey with Spanish. We will look at the alphabet, numbers, counting and basic greetings.
