I also have a second job working for Peterborough United as a safety steward. I have worked there for 15 years and mainly work with the youth risk base fans in the home terrace.

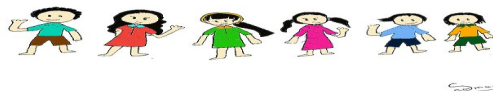
In my spare time I enjoy spending time with my family and usually end up being mums taxi service for my 8 year old daughter! I also enjoy going to pilates.
